QUESTIONS YOU MIGHT GET ASKED

WHY ARE YOU IN THE SAME CLOTHES FOR THREE DAYS?

So glad you asked! I'm taking part in The Sudsy Challenge to help support the 41,000 New Zealanders who are experiencing homelessness on any given night.

WHAT'S THE SUDSY CHALLENGE?

The Sudsy Challenge is about keeping your kit on for three days, talking about homelessness with those around you; and raising vital funds for Orange Sky; so everyone can have access to a laundry van like Sudsy!

WHO IS SUDSY?

Sudsy is the name of Orange Sky's first ever mobile laundry van built in 2014 in Australia. Since then, the organisation has grown A LOT. They now have 5 vans across 4 locations supporting people doing it tough in New Zealand.

WHY THREE DAYS?

It took Nic and Lucas, the co-founders of Orange Sky, three days (and three sets of washing machines and dryers!) to build Sudsy and get the van working. On day three, a friend named Jordan used the service and taught Nic and Lucas that while clean clothes were important, it was the conversation and connection that mattered more.

WHAT MADE YOU SIGN UP FOR THE CHALLENGE?

Maybe you signed up because you want to help your local community. Or maybe you want to ensure that everybody has access to clean clothes, a warm shower and great conversation! Everyone has their own reason for getting involved.

WHERE DOES THE MONEY GO?
